

Publications and Distribution Committee Report

The 2012 Minutebook was published on paper and online, thanks again to the faithful work of David Finke and Sharon Haworth. (Last year I erroneously reported that the 2012 Minutebook was published, but actually I meant to report on the 2011 Minutebook.)

Among Friends is now being published on a different schedule -- Fall and Spring, instead of Summer and Winter. We hope that this new schedule will encourage more submissions related to annual sessions. Marcia Nelson edited the Fall 2012 and Spring 2013 issues, and has generously agreed to continue for another year.

The 2012 Plummer Lecture by Mark Mattaini has been published online. Paper publication of the 2011 and 2012 Plummer Lectures has not yet been accomplished. We hope that Way will open for this work next year.

We gratefully acknowledge the excellent work of Wil Brant, who had redesigned the ILYM website and managed it for the past several years but has now laid it down. Sean West has kindly stepped up to manage the website, and to convert the paper version of *Among Friends* to its online version. Sean also administers an ILYM Facebook page that helps ILYM friends connect with each other.

At Fall Continuing Committee we added a fourth text element to our previous three, which are to be included on all ILYM publications. They are: author and committee names, date of publication (month/year), "Illinois Yearly Meeting" and the ILYM website address (www.ilym.org).
